On 28th July 2012, Sri Hanuman Lakhs Patri (Tamalapakulu) Yagnam will be held at Telugu Community Association, 28 St Mary's Street, Preston PR1 5LN. We kindly request if there is any devotee(s) want to involve in this yagnam, want to give hearty welcome. This kind of yagnam has never been performed in our temple. This yagnam is to give prosperity for our lives and remove any evils, and if there is any malefic effect by any planet(s) in our Janam Kundali is to demise that of malefic planet(s) and grant the strength of the planet(s) to better results for our career, family life, education, business, marriage, children and etc; Hanuman is only the saviour who has control over such malefic planets like Saturn, Mars, Rahu and Ketu. Hanuman has supreme power to control over the Grahas of our Janam Kudali. Saturn is the most malefic planet that can ruin or give success according to the placement of the planet in our natal chart, it is the ruler and teaches the past karma and bestow those with good deeds, the planet mostly criticised for destruction but it's not what they say, it has most power to give justice and moksha and puts us into righteousness to lead self realisation. Hanuman has the power over these planets and he is the mangal karaka. It is entirely up to devotees' wish.

Performing the Yagnam

The Yagnam will commence in the morning about 8am and will continue till the evening. So it is very big process if you would like to involve. Bearing in mind that any health condition people want to involve you may do so, if there is any instance that you would like to take medicine and want to eat you may do so, but we recommend it would be advisable that of those medical condition people can give their name(s), gothram and it will be performed accordingly, this is to prevent any potential danger to your health. We also request all devotees not to disturb or distract or cannot be stopped of this performance while it's last. Note: Please don't expect the results without performing the yagnam. This may seem contradicts of those medical condition people. If a person can sit with pure heart and devotion, god accepts. If person born blind has never seen this world and don't know what Shiva Lingam looks like, how can this person to be perform the pooja! He/she don't know what the objects such as what shivalingam, car, and house look alike, so the only option they have is to perform with the sense. I hope you all understand my point.

Requirements

We kindly request if any devotee of the Brahmin cast people would to participate in this performance would be great help. We are assuming that 11 candidates are required or if there is more it would be excellent. We request all the participant devotees to forward their names to the priest as soon as possible, who will explain the process of this yagnam. We are aiming to perform this seamless yagnam with your support and your help.

Cost for the yagnam

Those of you would like to participate in this yagnam or want their names only chanted in the pooja, please make a donation. Devotees who want to buy 1 basket of tamalapakulu or want to give the cost of the basket, which we estimate, £15 per basket. We assuming that the basket consists of 3000 leaves but we are not sure of that. If any devotee would like to give for more than one basket please do so with your name and gothram to the priest. We are aiming to collect money for 35 to 40 baskets, if there is excessive money we receive; this money will be used to provide other pooja items. If there is any surplus money left, this will be given to temple to cover the costs for usage. Bearing in mind that devotee paying £15 will only cover for the basket, if any extra money is given this will help to provide food and other pooja items.

Dinner after the yagnam

We are not sure of the finishing time for yagnam. So in order to accommodate for elderly, young and travellers or for any reason those who cannot abstain from having food, we will be cooking in early morning and will be left upstairs on the table. Anyone who wishing to eat can go upstairs and can be self served. There will be not many items for cooking, we strictly aiming to provide rice, dosakai papu, pickles, ghee, and yoghurt, a proper Brahmin bhojnam.
